PETRINI ELECTED PRESIDENT OF MUNICIPAL BAR GROUP

Christopher J. Petrini, Esq., Town Counsel for the Town of Framingham, has been elected President of the City Solicitors and Town Counsel Association for the 2009-2010 year at the Association's recent annual business meeting.
